SUBJECT: Optional Texas A&M University System Inland Marine Insurance Policy

Texas A&M Research and Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service through the Texas A&M University System have an Inland Marine insurance policy available that can be purchased for agency equipment either owned or leased. The Inland Marine insurance policy provides a transfer of risk for units who could not afford to replace certain scheduled property or electronic equipment in the event of a total loss.

For your convenience, attached are a policy outline and a list of examples of what can be considered scheduled property versus electronic equipment. Types of items covered may include, but not limited to, scientific equipment, computers, printers, servers, copiers, televisions, and cameras.
