Additional information, including registration details, will be available soon. Conference attendance is limited to 50 participants.

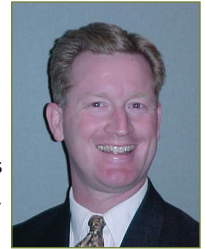
