PROCEDURE STATEMENT

System Policy 25.07, Contract Administration, and System Regulation 25.07.01, Contract Administration, Delegations, and Reporting, outline requirements for contract administration procedures to include specific delegations of authority for contracts and agreements. These delegations also encompass employment contracts, contracts and grants for research, and educational and service activities "consistent with a component's mission," along with others. System Policy 51.04, Delegations of Authority on Construction Projects, contains delegations of authority for construction contracts.

This procedure establishes the delegation of authority and contract administration procedures for Texas A&M AgriLife Research (AgriLife Research), in accordance with System Policy 25.07 and System Regulation 25.07.01.

PROCEDURES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Delegation of authority within Texas A&M AgriLife (AgriLife) is specified in the *AgriLife Table of Delegated Authority*, which identifies the individuals authorized to approve documents in accordance with the *AgriLife Delegation of Authority*.
