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#### PROCEDURE SUMMARY

The Texas A&M University System (A&M System) Policy 25.07, *Contract Administration*, and A&M System Regulation 25.07.01, *Contract Administration*, *Delegations, and Reporting*, outline requirements for contract administration procedures to include specific delegations of authority for contracts and agreements. These delegations also encompass employment contracts, contracts and grants for research, and educational and service activities "consistent with a component's mission," along with others. A&M System Policy 51.04, *Delegations of Authority on Construction Projects*, contains delegations of authority for construction contracts.

This procedure establishes the delegation of authority and contract administration procedures for Texas A&M Veterinary Medical Diagnostic Laboratory (TVMDL), in accordance with A&M System Policy 25.07 and A&M System Regulation 25.07.01.

### PROCEDURES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The TVMDL delegation of authority is specified in the <u>TVMDL Delegation of Authority for Contract Administration</u>, which identifies the individuals authorized to approve documents relating to contracts and agreements.
