SUMMARY

General Description: Performs trade work at the semi-skilled level and serves as a working leader of a maintenance crew.

DUTIES

Typical: Works as a member or working leader of a crew performing a varied assortment of jobs; works as a crafts person as determined necessary by foremen or leader; performs maintenance and modification to buildings of the University; performs preventive maintenance repairs on small motors, equipment, and small tools; sets up stages and seating; moves equipment and supplies intra-campus using specialized materials handling equipment including a forklift; moves heavy objects up and down stairs; performs related duties as required.

SUPERVISION

Received: General instruction and periodic review from Maintenance Foreman or other immediate supervisor.

Given: General supervision to other maintenance employees in lower classifications when participating in the assigned tasks.

EDUCATION

Required: Ability to comprehend instructions.

Preferred: High school graduation or any equivalent combination of training and experience and specific training in area related to a particular assignment.

EXPERIENCE

Required: Two years in building, machinery, and/or equipment maintenance, installation and repair work; materials handling, warehouse operation or landscape irrigation systems.

Preferred: None.

LICENSES, CERTIFICATES OR REGISTRATION

Required: Valid driver's license and good driving record. Must be able to obtain State of Texas class "C" vehicle operator's license within 30 days of employment.

Preferred: None.
