SUMMARY

General Description: Operates farm equipment, trucks, and riding mowers; operates equipment used in maintaining streets and sidewalks.

DUTIES

Typical: Maintains large lawn areas with tractor-towed mowers, gang mowers, fertilizing and weed killer distributors, and tractor-drawn curb edgers; moves supplies and materials to work areas in trucks, trailers or other equipment; operates spray equipment for insecticides and fungicides on large lawn areas and large trees; operates mechanical equipment used in the general maintenance of streets and sidewalks; stripes streets for parking and installs traffic signs; accomplishes rough carpentry and painting; cleans and maintains tools, equipment, materials, and supplies; assumes duties of supervisor during absences; performs related duties as required.

SUPERVISION

Received: General instruction and frequent review from Grounds Foreman.

Given: General instruction and frequent review to Groundskeeper I assisting in the work.

EDUCATION

Required: Completion of eighth grade or any equivalent combination of training and experience.

Preferred: High school graduation.

EXPERIENCE

Required: One or more years in the operation of tractors, trucks, and other mechanical equipment.

Preferred: More than three years experience in the above.

LICENSES, CERTIFICATES OR REGISTRATION

Required: Valid driver's license. Must be able to obtain State of Texas class "C" vehicle operator's license within 30 days of employment.

Preferred: State of Texas class "A" vehicle operator's license.

KNOWLEDGE, ABILITIES AND SKILLS

Typical: Use of farm tractors, trucks, riding mowers, air hammers, power driven rollers and other equipment used in the general maintenance of lawns, streets, sidewalks and flower beds.
