RULE STATEMENT

To provide the highest level of protection for the health of all employees and visitors using or working in Texas A&M AgriLife Research (AgriLife Research) facilities and vehicles and to comply with System Policy 34.05, *Smoking*, all AgriLife Research facilities and vehicles are hereby designated as "smoke free."

REASON FOR RULE

This rule is required by System Policy 34.05, and provides guidelines concerning smoking and tobacco use in AgriLife Research facilities and vehicles.

PROCEDURES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1.0 All on-campus employees will follow the Texas A&M University Smoking Rule.
- 2.0 Housing owned by AgriLife Research will be smoke-free.
- 3.0 Buildings/facilities and vehicles other than those identified in paragraph 2.0 owned or leased by AgriLife Research will be tobacco free and smoke-free.
- 4.0 Each administrative head of AgriLife Research centers/stations will ensure the following:
 - 4.1 Notices are posted at each entrance which indicates that the facility is a tobacco-free area.
 - 4.2 An area adjacent to the facility may be designated as a smoking area. The following guidelines may aid in the selection and establishment of an appropriate area:
 - A. The smoking area will be covered, if possible.
 - B. Do not designate an area where non-smokers will be in direct contact with the smoke when entering or exiting a building.
 - C. Provide non-flammable containers with lids for disposal of cigarette or cigar stubs.

DEFINITIONS

Tobacco – Means all forms of tobacco products including but not limited to cigarettes, cigars, pipes, water pipes (hookah), bidis, kreteks, electronic cigarettes, smokeless tobacco, snuff and chewing tobacco

Buildings/facilities (other than housing) – includes indoor air space including foyers, entryways, individual faculty and administrative offices, sidewalks, shops, covered arenas, animal working facilities, parking lots, walkways, and attached parking structures immediately adjacent to all such buildings and structures
