- *Perform apiary inspection service duties to prevent, detect and/or eradicate diseases of the honey bee as outlined in the Texas Bee Laws under Section I, Chapter 131 of the Texas Agricultural Code.
- *Assist with public education activities and presentation of technical information to various audiences.
