## *SUMMARY*

**General Description:** Supervises and participates in farm work including the care of animals and protection of crops.

## *DUTIES*

**Typical:** Supervises and participates in care of and experimentation with livestock and crops; supervises Farm Workers in the use of trucks, tractors, and farm equipment; directs the repair and construction of small buildings and makes repairs on farm equipment; checks condition of animals daily and carries out treatment for minor ailments; moves cattle from one pasture to another; renovates, seeds, and mows pastures; maintains accurate feeding, breeding, and herd records; keeps animal, feed, and equipment inventories; selects and grooms livestock for classroom demonstration and show purposes; supervises the weighing, mixing, and grinding of feeds and controls feeding methods; supervises and participates in milking, weighing milk, and keeping milk records; checks barns, milk house, sheds, pens, and equipment for proper condition and cleanliness; manages field operations for agronomic and horticultural crops, including irrigation and application of herbicides and insecticides; keeps crop production records; performs related duties as required.

## *SUPERVISION*

**Received:** General instruction and periodic review from departmental administrators and staff members.

**Given:** General instruction and frequent review to Farm Workers, Laborers, and Student Workers.

## *EDUCATION*

**Required:** High school graduation or any equivalent combination of training and experience.

**Preferred:** College level courses in agriculture.

## *EXPERIENCE*

**Required:** Four years in livestock feeding, breeding, and farm management.

**Preferred:** Additional experience in farm management.
