### *SUMMARY*

**General Description:** Supports research or teaching laboratories, farms or ranches by performing specialized tasks.

### *DUTIES*

**Typical:** Uses field research equipment, procedures, and apparatus in conducting field experiments; performs a variety of work assignments utilizing mechanical, carpentry, and welding skills; assists in palpation, artificial insemination, and disease analyses; operates farm tractors for plowing, preparing soil for planting, cultivating, and harvesting field crops, fruits, and vegetables; prepares analyses on data collected; performs related duties as required.

### *SUPERVISION*

**Received:** General instruction and periodic review from immediate supervisor.

**Given:** Occasional supervision of Agricultural Research Workers I and Laborers.

### *EDUCATION*

**Required:** High school graduation or any equivalent combination of training and experience.

**Preferred:** Related college level courses in agriculture.

### *EXPERIENCE*

**Required:** One year of independently performing general farm, ranch or field laboratory work at a research unit.

**Preferred:** None.

### *LICENSES, CERTIFICATES OR REGISTRATION*
