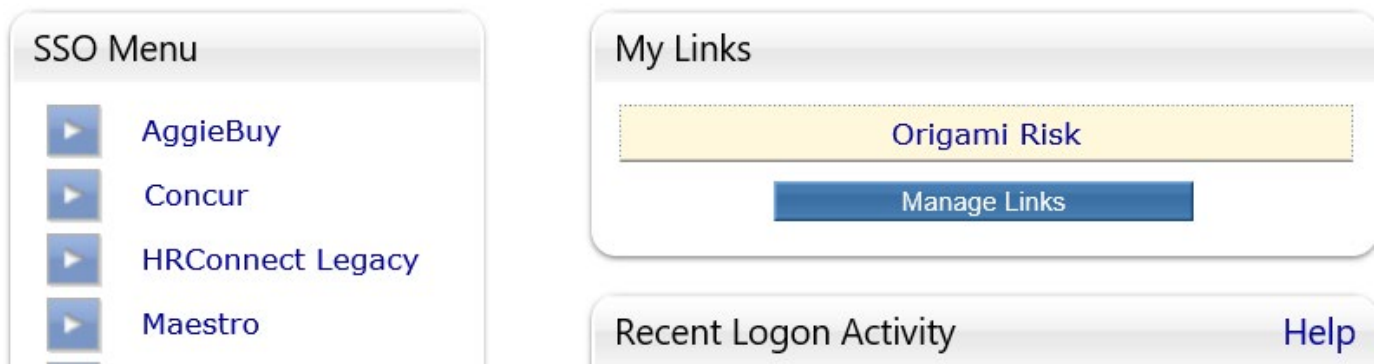
SUBJECT: SSO Integration of Origami Risk - Update

UPDATE: Since the software is not an enterprise-wide application, Origami will not appear within our SSO menus, as originally hoped. However, users may create a link, using the provided URL.

To do so:

1. Log into **SSO**
2. Under the SSO Menu, click **Manage Menu**
3. Select **My Links**
4. Select **Add User Links**
5. When there, copy and paste the Origami URL
(<https://live.origamirisk.com/origami/account/Login?account=tamus>) into the **Link** field
6. In the **Description** field, put "Origami Risk"
7. Select **Save**

Once you return to the SSO home screen, Origami Risk should appear under the My Links section, like so:

Single Sign On (SSO) Integration of Origami Risk

In compliance with The Texas A&M University System (TAMUS) Office of Information Technology's security initiatives, we are integrating our enterprise applications into the Texas A&M University System's authentication system, [Single Sign-On \(SSO\)](#). Integration of the System Office Risk Management's Risk Management Information System (RMIS), Origami Risk (Origami), is complete, and will go live effective 1 April 2021.

Users will now be required to access the system through this **updated SSO [Origami link](#)**. Users will now be required to perform [Two Factor Authentication](#) in SSO. If the Two Factor Authentication process was already performed, even to access other applications, and the SSO user remains logged-on, users will be immediately directed to Origami. If users had not performed the Two Factor Authentication, and are not already logged-on, they will be required to do so, in order to access Origami. Once logged-on, users will be immediately directed to Origami.

Users are highly encouraged to bookmark / save to favorites this updated [Origami link](#) in order to continue to access the site in the future.

One:Stop Shop

Origami has been integrated into the [TAMUS Single Sign-On \(SSO\)](#) platform! The feature will be released on April 1st. That's right, you will be able to access Origami just as you do other web-based applications! Simply log-on using a campus or agency log-on like NetID, or Island ID UINs. Per System Enterprise Applications Office of Information Technology:

Single Sign-On is the system which handles your logon access to web based applications which have chosen to use Single Sign-On as their authentication method.

After logging in, you will be presented with a list of applications for which you may be authorized.

This will provide you with secure access to Origami with just one click, following your initial login. Single sign-on helps employees save time, prevents lost or forgotten passwords, and reduces the risk of password phishing.
