Summary of "Recent Drone Updates" pdf:

DJI drones have recently been added to the BIS Entity List, <u>AgriLife personnel will not be</u> <u>allowed to make any purchases of DJI drones or their affiliates from any vendor. This includes purchases made through AggieBuy or with ProCards.</u> Please check the attachment for additional information.

We do not have an extensive listing of other drones available, however, we have listed a few known to us below. Please be advised that some drones may require a TCP (Technology Control Plan) put in place by our Export Controls office.
