TO: All AgriLife Bryan/College Station Benefit Eligible Employees

SUBJECT: AgriLife Flu Vaccine Clinics

Vaccinations are now available at many convenient local retail pharmacies covered at 100% through your A&M System prescription-drug benefit. These typically do not require an appointment and are the same effective medications as those from your physician’s office.

Along with protection from the flu, your prescription-drug benefit plan covers several other vaccines at 100%, which can be administered by pharmacists at participating network pharmacies:

- Flu (seasonal influenza)
- Tetanus/Diphtheria/Pertussis
- Hepatitis
- Human Papillomavirus (HPV)
- Meningitis
- Pneumonia
- Shingles/Zoster
- Travel Vaccines (rabies, typhoid, yellow fever, etc.)
- Childhood Vaccines (MMR, etc.)

There are two ways to locate a participating pharmacy:

1. Sign in at [Express-Scripts.com](https://www.express-scripts.com) and click **Prescriptions, then Find a Pharmacy** to search for in-network pharmacies convenient for you.
2. Call the number on your Express Scripts member ID card to find a participating pharmacy near you.

Contact your network pharmacy in advance to inquire about vaccine availability, age restrictions, and current vaccination schedules. Also, don’t forget to present your member ID card to the pharmacist.

Employees and their family members are welcome to participate. **No cost if filed with insurance.** Consent form required.



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Complete the [Walgreens-consent-form.pdf](#) and **bring it with you** along with a **copy of your driver's license or ID card** and **health insurance ID card** to receive your flu vaccine.

**Age restrictions**--must be at least 7 years old.

Cash or check cost **without insurance**: \$40.99 Regular Dose (exact dollar amount required; will not be able to provide change)

High Dose - \$72.99 cash or check only and will not be filed with insurance. (exact dollar amount required; will not be able to provide change)
