Maximum Allowable Reimbursement Rates for Sept. 1 – 30, 2022

For cities/counties not listed in the GSA:

- Lodging In-State/Out-of-State – Up to \$96
- Meals In-State/Out-of-State – Up to \$59

Maximum Allowable Reimbursement Rates effective Oct. 1, 2022– Aug. 31, 2023

For cities/counties not listed in the GSA:

- Lodging In-State/Out-of-State – Up to \$98
- Meals In-State/Out-of-State – Up to \$59

Personal Car Mileage – mileage reimbursement will continue to be 62.5 cents per mile (Sept. 1 – Dec. 31, 2022)
