### **Maestro Access**

Maestro logon is now done through Single Sign On (SSO). If you access the Maestro URL directly it will redirect to SSO.

### **My Account List**

Researchers and administrators have the ability to create a list of their favorite accounts and choose that account list, rather than their full account list, as their landing page. See the attached information sheet on how to choose accounts for favorites list and set as landing page.

### **Award Notification**

SRS has begun using Maestro to distribute the Sponsored Project Summary Report (also known as SPS or award notification). You will receive an email containing a link that will direct you to Maestro where you will login and be taken directly to the project. A PDF copy of the SPS will also be attached to the email.

The distribution is based on routing paths previously established through Tribbie Sandner. Please coordinate any changes to the electronic routing path with Tribbie.

If a project includes PIs or Co-PIs in system members that have not established their Maestro paths you will continue to receive the SPS by email as previously done. Currently TAMU, AgriLife and TEES are using the electronic SPS.

Coming soon you will also see modifications to the Maestro screens to help ease navigation through the Maestro system.

## Create "Favorites" Account List and Make It Landing Page

### Set Favorites as Landing Page

The "Favorite Accounts" page is a link on the left hand tool bar of the account module.

To make this your landing page, go to My Settings, Personal Settings and Select Home, choose Researcher→Accounts→Favorite Accounts. Make sure to save this change. When you log into Maestro in the future, you will automatically go to your favorite account list.
