Multistate Research Projects (formerly Regional Projects) are cooperatively planned research of concern to multiple states or region. Proposals are posted on-line. PIs can choose which objectives they plan to work on.

To View the Proposal:

1. Go to the National Information Management Support System (NIMSS): <http://nimss.umd.edu/>
2. Enter your login and password. (If you don't have one, you can register at the NIMSS site.)
3. Select "project" then "View Projects" from the top menu.
4. Enter the project number.
