## General

Vendor will provide four (4) high-volume air samplers designed to collect total suspended particulate (TSP) on 8"x10" filters as provided in 40 CFR 50 Appendix B, paragraphs 7.2 and 7.3. Vendor will also provide one (1) NIST-traceable, air flow calibration kit suitable for use with all samplers.

## **Specifications**

- The samplers shall conform in every respect to the design and performance specifications given in 40 CFR 50 Appendix B, paragraphs 7.2 and 7.3.
- The blower motors shall be brushless and shall use 110-125 VAC 60Hz single-phase electricity.
- Each sampler shall be shipped with an 8"x10" filter holder assembly ("cassette").
- Each sampler shall feature a constant-flow, mass-based controller with a 7-day mechanical timer and an elapsed-time indicator.
- Each sampler shall feature a standard chart recorder for air flow rate and shall be shipped with a minimum of one recorder pen and a minimum of sixty (60) circular charts.
- Each sampler enclosure and gabled roof shall be fabricated from aluminum for weather resistance.
- The gabled roof/inlet for each sampler shall be attached to the sampler enclosure with hinges to permit convenient access to the filter cassette before and after sampling.
- The NIST-traceable air flow calibration kit shall be compatible with the samplers shipped and shall be capable of calibrating the samplers' air flow rate in accordance with the performance specifications given in 40 CFR 50 Appendix B.
