Re-Solicitation: Custom Fabrication of Panels

Terms and Conditions: Vendor's quote submittal is subject to the Agency's terms and conditions, which are available at <http://agrilife.org/admin/files/2013/05/terms-conditions-bid.pdf> or may be faxed or emailed upon request.

Payment Terms: Net 30 days upon receipt and acceptance of item or receipt of correct invoice, whichever is later.

Governing Law: Any contract resulting from this request for quote shall be construed and governed by the laws of the State of Texas.

Public Information: (a) The vendor acknowledges that the Agency is obligated to strictly comply with the Public Information Act, Chapter 552, Texas Government Code, in responding to any request for public information pertaining to any resulting Agreement, as well as any other disclosure of information required by applicable Texas law.

(b) Upon the Agency's written request, the vendor will provide specified public information exchanged or created under any resulting Agreement that is not otherwise excepted from disclosure under Chapter 552, Texas Government Code, to the Agency in a non-proprietary format acceptable to the Agency. As used in this provision, "public information" has the meaning assigned Section 552.002, Texas Government Code, but only includes information to which the Agency has a right of access.

(c) The vendor acknowledges that the Agency is required to post a copy of any resulting fully executed Agreement on its Internet website in compliance with Section 2261.253(a)(1), Texas Government Code.

Warranty: Any quote submitted should include complete warranty information for the items being offered.

Delivery: Must be delivered no later than July 1, 2018. Any quote submitted should include delivery time for the items being offered.

Award Based on Best Value: Texas A&M AgriLife Research reserves the right to accept or reject any or all quotes, to waive informalities and technicalities, to accept the offer considered most advantageous and award based on best value criteria. In determining what is the best value to the Agency, the Agency shall consider any or all of the following:

- 1) purchase price;
- 2) the reputation of the vendor and the vendor's goods or services;
- 3) the quality of the vendor's goods or services;
- 4) the extent to which the goods or services meet the Agency's needs;
- 5) the vendor's past relationship with the Agency;
- 6) the total long-term cost to the Agency in acquiring the vendor's good or services;
- 7) the length and coverage of the vendor's warranty;
- 8) the delivery time;
- 9) any other relevant factor that a private business entity might consider in selecting a vendor.

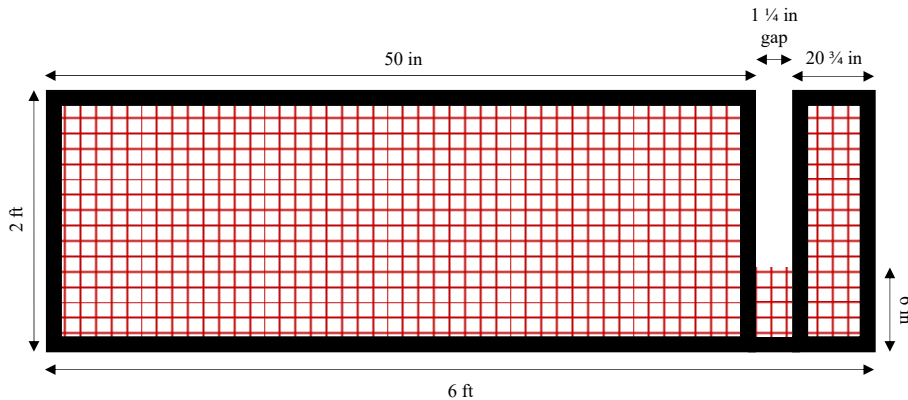
Bidders are encouraged to provide any and all information they believe may be helpful in determining the best value to the Agency include information directly related to the above-mentioned criteria.

No specifications or information discussed during a site visit, shall supersede, alter, or amend the specifications listed in this request for quote.

Custom fabricated panels per the following specifications:

- Frame to be constructed of primer coated $\frac{3}{4}$ ", 14-gauge square tubing
- Frame must be constructed, and measure, as detailed in the diagram below



- 2' x 6' sheet of 16-gauge, galvanized welded wire with 1" x 1" mesh shall be secured to each frame with #10 x $\frac{3}{4}$ " self-tapping screws and $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 1" fender washers, except for in the 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " gap in the frame
- Wire shall only cover the bottom 6" of the 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " gap in the frame
- The photo below is of an existing panel the Agency wishes to replicate. This should be used as a visual reference only. All panels should be fabricated using the measurements listed above.



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Shipping and handling charges, F.O.B. Destination, to 1201 Harvey Mitchell Parkway, College Station, TX 77843.

Panels must be delivered or ready for pick up (if the Agency so chooses) no later than July 1, 2018.

Delivery will be at the Agency's option. Dependent upon the location, the Agency may choose to pick up the panels, and not be assessed a delivery fee. This option will be at the Agency's sole discretion. Please note the location that the panels can be picked up from on the quote.
