The State of Texas and Automotive Dealerships with cooperative contracts have provided AgriLife with the following vehicle ordering information:

Ford:

E-Series: Order bank for the 2024 E-Series timing will be announced next year.

F-150: Order bank for 2023 F-150 will open late next year.

Super Duty: Order bank for the 2023 Super Duty is expected to open late next year.

Transit: Ford anticipates order bank for 2023 Transit to open late next year.

Explorers & Expeditions: Accepting orders, current estimated delivery time is 180-210 days.

Chevrolet:

Most 2023 model Chevy`s will begin accepting orders again on May 5, 2022, with production starting in July-August.

Toyota:

Only accepting 2022 model year vehicle orders for Toyota Avalon and Toyota Corolla. Will begin accepting orders on 2023 model year vehicle orders in Q3 of 2022. The exact dates for various vehicle lines have not yet been released.

Dodge:

Only accepting 2022 model year vehicle orders on the Chrysler 300 and Ram 1500 Classic. Will begin accepting orders on 2023 model year orders in Q4 of 2022. The exact dates for various vehicle lines have not yet been released.

AgriLife Purchasing has been experiencing major delays in delivery and, in some cases, order cancellations. Currently, delivery times have been estimated anywhere from 100-400 days after the order placement.
